• In September:

There were 4,963 total trail visitors based on Trafx counter data. This is a decrease of 582 visitors as compared to last month. This is a YTD decrease of 795 visitors from this time last year. This data includes traffic from Leadmine, Riverlands, Heins Farm, Plimpton, and Long Pond trail heads.

 The most visited property was Leadmine (Shattuck, Morgan, Pinelands) with 3,948 visitors, followed by Riverlands with 449 visitors, Heins Farm with 263 visitors, Long Pond with 187 visitors, and Plimpton with 116 visitors.
