WE PROPOSE TO REPLACE A FAILING SHORELINE WALL, BUILT OF STONE & MORTAR, WITH A WALL CONSTRUCTED OF LARGE DRY LAID STONES. THE WALL IS 190' LONG AND 3 1/2' TALL. THE NEW WALL WILL STEP BACK FOR STABILITY. THE STONES WILL RANGE IN SIZE WITH THE LARGEST BEING 3' AROUND. A MINIMUM OF 12" THICK LAYER OF DOUBLE WASHED 3/4" STONE WILL BE BEHIND THE WALL STONES. STONE STAIRS WILL BE PLACED WITHIN THE WALL. WORK FOR THIS PROJECT WILL BE PERFORMED BY MICHAEL THIBEAULT DBA LANDSCAPE EVOLUTION. POWER EQUIPMENT (8000# MINI EXCAVATOR) WILL BE USED TO EXCAVATE THE OLD WALL AND PLACE NEW STONES. THIS MACHINE WILL REMAIN ON THE TERRACE THAT THE HOUSE SITS ON. NO SOIL WILL BE STOCKPILED DURING CONSTRUCTION. THE WORK WILL TAKE PLACE DURING THE LAKE DRAW DOWN. WORK DESCRIPTION: 15 Long Avenue, Sturbridge, MA

We propose to replace a failing shoreline wall, built of stone & mortar, with a wall constructed of large dry laid stones. The wall is 190' long and 3 ½' tall. The new wall will step back for stability. The stones will range in size with the largest being 3' around. A minimum of 12" thick layer of double washed ¾" stone will be behind the wall stones. Stone stairs will be placed within the wall.

Work for this project will be performed by Michael Thibeault DBA Landscape Evolution. Power equipment (8000# mini excavator) will be used to excavate the old wall and place new stones. This machine will remain on the terrace that the house sits on. No soil will be stockpiled during construction.

The work will take place during the lake draw down. Staked straw wattles and siltation fence will be placed along the length of the shoreline below the work area.
