

Dear Board Members:

On June 11, 2019, DC Engineering & Survey, Inc. (DC) inspected the above referenced property for any wetland resource areas. The site is a small, approximately one half acre parcel located on the southwest side of Big Alum Pond in Sturbridge. The site contains an existing single family dwelling with mostly grassed area with terrain that slopes from The Trail towards the pond then drops down to the shoreline.

The site was inspected for indicators of wetland resource areas and the edge of the water is to be considered the limit. The boundary is the bank of Big Alum Pond and is an abrupt change of slope and well is marked by the first observable break in slope or the mean annual flood elevation. A 100-foot buffer zone extends horizontally outward from the edge of the delineated boundary.

The proposed work area is located almost entirely outside the 100-ft bufferzone except for an area of existing gravel driveway that is proposed to be converted to loam and grass. The proposed work to the site includes asphalt paving an existing gravel driveway. The limits of asphalt can be seen on the proposed site plan and not the entire gravel area is to be paved. Some portions are to be converted to loam and grass.
