#### **NARRATIVE**

Summit Engineering & Survey, Inc. has been tasked to design and permit the abatement of a nuisance as adjudged and ordered by the Superior Court of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in Action No. 1285CV001096 as consolidated with Action No. 1485CV00517, Count III, in a Final Judgement dated February 6, 2019. The applicants, Gary and Margaret Allard were the defendants in the above mentioned action and judgement was entered against them. The action was the result of complaints against the Allards for property damage resulting from the development of their property.

The property is located at 31 South Shore Drive, a private road. On the property are a single family residence and a detached two-story garage with associated infrastructure to include a graveled driveway, onsite sewage disposal system and a private domestic well. The residence, according to Town Assessors' records was built in 2007. This construction was regulated under an Order of Conditions issued by the Sturbridge Conservation Commission in 2005, DEP File No. 300-508, as amended in 2006 and recorded in the Worcester District Registry of Deeds (South) in Deed Book 38479, Page 145. A Certificate of Compliance for the work regulated by this Order was issued by the Sturbridge Conservation Commission in 2010 and is recorded in Deed Book 46189, Page 307. The two-story garage was constructed 2012. A Request for Determination of Applicability for its construction was filed with the Conservation Commission which resulted in a negative determination.

The nuisance resulted from the manner in which the entrance of the driveway at 31 South Shore Drive was final graded coupled with the continued maintenance of hay bale/soil berm along South Shore Drive. To eliminate the nuisance, it is proposed to capture all upstream runoff waters coming down South Shore Drive. This will be accomplished by installing a catch basin, a swale, an infiltration trench and drop inlet above the Allard driveway, these devices will be piped under the driveway into a large diameter catch basin which acts as a final sediment trap. The outlets from this trap will empty on a stone dispersion pad located to the north and up gradient of the wetland system. The portion of the berm located south of the Allard driveway will be

removed and the shoulder regraded to define a shallow grassed swale to carry any remaining waters from South Shore Drive.

As proposed the drainage system will mimic the runoff pattern that existed prior to the construction of the Allard driveway by diverting the runoff off South Shore Drive and to an area north of the wetland. Removing the hay bale berm and sloping and grassing the shoulder will provide a filter strip for which any remaining waters on South Shore Drive can be treated prior to entering the wetland and perennial stream.

Erosion control barriers consisting of silt fence and straw wattle will be established prior to any soil disturbance or tree removal. These barriers are to remain in place until the entire area has been stabilized and grass filtration strip functions as it is intended.

It is the preparer's belief given the Final Judgement issued by the Court, that there is no other reasonable alternate than that shown and that the proposed are exempt from full compliance with DEP's policy for Stormwater Management. Efforts have been made to treat all potential discharges to the maximum extent practical given the site constraints.
