THE APPLICANT IS PROPOSING TO CONSTRUCT A SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENCE LOCATED AT 70 WESTWOOD DRIVE (MAP 111, STREET CODE 678, PARCEL 70) WITH ASSOCIATED SITE WORK TO INCLUDE CONNECTING WITH TOWN SEWER IN WESTWOOD DRIVE. A E-ONE SEWER EJECTOR PUMP WILL BE INSTALLED FOR CONNECTION TO THE EXISTING TOWN SEWER. THE PATH OF THE DISCHARGE LINE WILL FOLLOW AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE, THE PROPOSED DRIVEWAY AS TO MINIMIZE DISTURBANCES ON THE SITE. THE PROPERTY CONFORMS TO ALL DIMENSIONAL REQUIREMENTS OF THE STURBRIDGE ZONING BYLAW. A PORTION OF THE PROPERTY IS UNDER THE JURISDICTION OF THE MASSACHUSETTS WETLANDS PROTECTION ACT AND THE TOWN OF STURBRIDGE WETLAND BYLAW. SOME OF THE IMPROVEMENTS AND A PORTION OF THE PROPOSED RESIDENCE ARE LOCATED WITHIN 100 FEET OF THE BANK OF A GREAT POND (CEDAR LAKE). A SEASONAL BOAT DOCK WILL BE INSTALLED AS SHOWN ON PLAN NUMBER 18115 IN VICINITY OF THE EXISTING SHED. THE LOT DOFS NOT LIF WITHIN A MAPPED AREA OF PRIORITY HABITAT OF RARE WILDLIFE AS SHOWN ON THE LATEST MASS GIS DATA LAYERS PRODUCED BY NATURAL HERITAGE AND ENDANGERED SPECIES PROGRAM, (NHESP)

THE LOT WAS CREATED IN 2006 AND IS RECORDED IN THE WORCESTER DISTRICT REGISTRY OF DEEDS IN PLAN BOOK 849, PLAN 29.

THE RESIDENCE IS PROPOSED TO ALLOW A REASONABLE VIEW AND ACCESS TO THE LAKE. THE GRADING AND TREE REMOVAL IS NECESSARY DUE TO THE TOPOGRAPHY OF THE SITE. ALL SITE WORK WILL BE OUTSIDE OF THE 50 FOOT BUFFER ZONE. A CURRENT FOOT PATH TO THE SHORE WILL NOT BE ALTERED. DRIP STRIPS ARE TO BE INSTALLED TO RECHARGE THE ROOF RUNOFF.






